Dutch context

Differences per technique group

Different committees on different levels

Assessment of techniques / and legislation on:

- housing systems
- air-cleaners

Regulation on techniques:

- manure application technologies
- covers for slurry containers
- separation technologies



manure separation

Protocol on separation installations

Pilots on manure processing via reverse osmosis

Committee for existing pilot program



manure application

Decree on the use of manures and fertilizers.

Obligation for low emissions application

Inspection visually after application

Only a limited amount of techniques in use

Pilot



Covers for slurry containers

Decree for slurry containers

Obligation to cover the container

Visual inspection

Guidance document for periodical inspection

No changes in the approach in the near future



Housing systems and air-cleaners

- TacRav (NTAC)
- Assessment on ammonia, odour and fine dust
- Assessment on housing systems and air-cleaners
- Test-protocols



Housing systems and air-cleaners

Proposal:

- Accept verification by International TAC
- Current protocol
- Accept institutes from Denmark and Germany
- No changes when an applicant doesn't want to apply internationally

This doesn't necessarily mean a technique is accepted if it is accepted in other countries
